Door Decorating Contest





Season of Gratitude

Dear Tom,

Because I don't have time to write this today, I am *taking* the time!

This morning, I stood waiting at Ocotillo for Efren to return from looking for bananas for me (I was 30 seconds in) you walked by, Tom, and asked if I was being helped. This small (but Large) gesture of kindness is the very essence of Westminster Village.

Over two years of living here, I have been approached in this way by staff members on all levels employment to ask if I needed help, or needed something. It happens very often and each time I am grateful. Sometimes a worker will rush from several yards away to remove the cone I have placed in my parking spot so that I can drive right in without having to exit and reenter my car and exit again. I always sense that the staff has been trained to do this. It makes me feel like royalty.

This morning you did it, Tom, the very CEO of the establishment. Just one of the helpful staff, indeed. It's a little thing but a very big thing. It does not go unnoticed.

Yesterday, in a quick response to the COVID-made necessary closing of the Cafe, a follow-up e-mail was sent to everyone to say that a *free* entree was available to anyone who wanted it because the Cafe was closed. And there *two* choices! I wanted to go out on my balcony and shout for the whole neighborhood that we live in the best place possible where thoughtfulness prevails.

When the announcement of the Cafe's closure had come, I immediate thought of all the residents who order there on Sunday: meals or light lunches or dinners. I felt sad that they might not be able to do that. My sadness evaporated almost immediately when the follow up e-mail came and I saw that the Administration (or whomever) was way ahead of me. Consideration prevails.

I am deeply touched by the care we receive and the caring of the whole staff. That is why I wanted to write immediately, even though a desk full of work calls to me.
