



## Coronavirus (COVID-19) Update 51

Tuesday afternoon we gathered in the cul-de-sac to observe a moment of silence in honor of all of the lives we have lost to COVID-19 and those of the greater Westminster Village family. This moment of silence was observed nationally and was hosted by LeadingAge and the Presidential Inaugural Committee. When I listen to what is happening at other campuses in the Phoenix area and the number of Residents they have lost along with the rate of infection that continues to plague them I am grateful for the support, understanding, patience, and concern that you have all had during these past ten months. While we mourn the lives we have lost to COVID, we also rejoice in the lives that have been saved because of our cautious approaches.

As of Tuesday the 19th, Arizona is reporting **685,699** confirmed cases of coronavirus and **11,266** coronavirus-related deaths since this pandemic began. Although we received our first dose of the vaccine last week, we must remain cautious and continue to limit our socializing until the 2nd dose is effective. We continue to evaluate the reopening of services such as in-person dining, housekeeping, non-emergency IT, and maintenance as it becomes safe to do so. While we are eager to begin rebuilding our community's culture, we are also hesitant to restore services that may compromise the health and safety of our Westminster Village family. There are several similar campuses around the Valley experiencing surges of new cases. One campus has reported 47 new positive cases just this past week, in part to relaxing their safety measures after receiving the first vaccine.

There is one new positive case to report in Independent Living. This Resident recently returned from the hospital back to their residence. They were later admitted to Weyrich Health Care Center where they tested positive upon admission. This Resident is being treated in the COVID unit pending further test results.

In closing, we would like to thank all those, especially our Resident services department, who made it possible to participate in the moment of silence yesterday afternoon. Please stay safe and continue your efforts to keep COVID off our campus. Thank you all for your continued patience, resilience, and support of one another.
