



Coronavirus (COVID-19) Update 55

Last week the majority of our community received their second vaccination. We now have 65% of our Employees vaccinated and 99% of our Residents. With the Moderna vaccine effective rate of 94.1% in preventing the COVID-19 virus you will soon be much less likely to contract the virus, however, because there is a slight risk of infection we highly recommend that you stay on campus as much as possible, minimizing off campus outings. If you do choose to venture out and visit a store, gathering, dining venue, the Doctor, etc., we ask that you self-isolate for 24 hours upon your return as a precaution to the community.

The following independent living services will resume on Tuesday:

- Ocotillo, for in person dining and table service. Reservations will be required and seating will be limited as we will continue to practice social distancing.
- The Garden Café, with limited seating.
- Housekeeping services, if you'd like to resume this service please contact 2026 to schedule your service.
- Small group (10 or less people) activities.

Also beginning Tuesday:

- Outdoor family visits will no longer require prior COVID testing, nor will family visits in unit 1040.
- The isolation period for Residents who leave campus is reduced to 24 hours.
- You may resume picking up your mail at the mailbox or call reception to make arrangements to continue having it delivered to your apartment.

We know you are eager to spend time off campus, catch up with family, friends, and enjoy activities you have missed; however, we ask you do so cautiously. Positivity rates in the greater community are declining and other similar communities as ours within Maricopa County are reporting a drastic drop in the number of positive cases on their campuses. This is very encouraging and we hope this trend continues as more and more people receive the vaccination and continue to practice safety guidelines.

The changes previously listed only affect independent living Residents at this time. All safety, visitor protocols for Weyrich Health Care Center and Sackton Assisted Living are still in effect. Safety protocols for in-person family visits also have not changed, guests are still required to test prior to their visit or have proof of vaccination.

Thank you all for your continued support and patience as we continue to work through this pandemic and begin to slowly resume some normalcy.
